# CAPE TRIBULATION, DAINTREE & OUTBACK WANDERER

**Traditional Aboriginal Fishing:** Join a member of the Kubirri Warra clan on their daily expedition across the beach and mudflats, into the mangroves of Kuyu Kuyu – Cooya Beach. **Aboriginal Art & Culture:** Visit Janbal Gallery for an art class with renowned Aboriginal artist, Brian 'Binna' Swindley. Binna will then guide you through his painting techniques as you create your own canvas to take home.

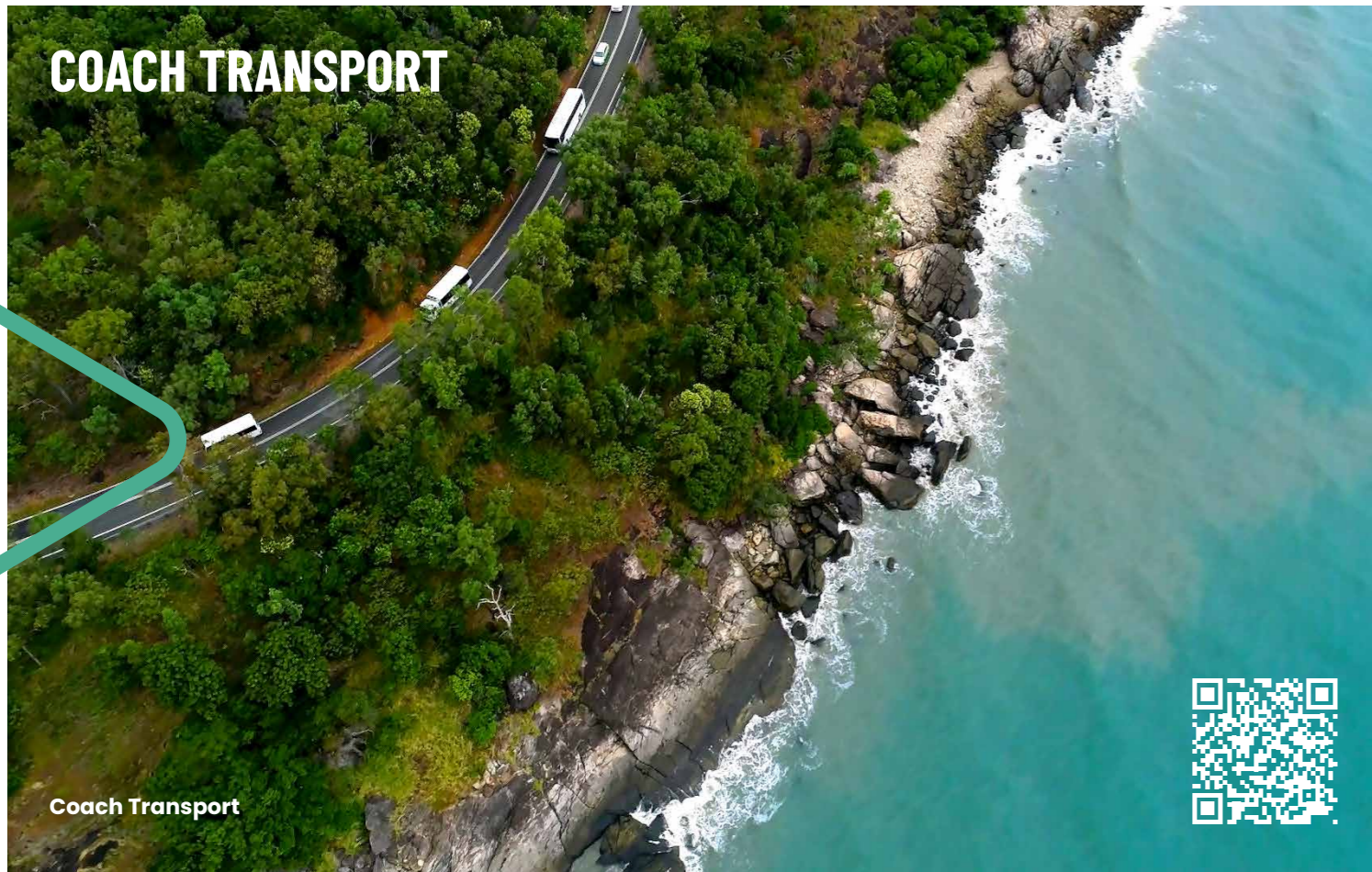
